Summary:

Unsolicited email claiming USPTO requires verification and

instructing recipient to call an “Examining Officer.” The sender domain (teasuspto.org) is not affiliated with USPTO (official domain is uspto.gov). Reply-To uses a different unrelated domain.

Header review shows the message was sent via Zoho (sender4-op-o16.zoho.com, IP 136.143.188.16) and passed SPF/DKIM for the spoofed domain, indicating the sender controls that domain and configured it for email. Bulk mail system identified as “Axemail Mail Engine.”

Assessment:

Likely phishing attempt using a lookalike domain to impersonate USPTO and induce contact for potential fraud.

No interaction or data shared. Email and headers available for review.
